Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) – Child-Friendly Version

1. Using Technology for Learning

- I will use school devices (computers, tablets, laptops) for school work and learning.
- I will follow my teacher's instructions when using technology.
- I will only use websites, apps, and tools my teacher has approved.

2. Being Safe Online

- I will keep my personal information private (my full name, address, phone number, passwords).
- I will tell an adult if I see something online that makes me feel worried, upset, or confused.
- I will only talk to people online if my teacher or a trusted adult says it is safe.

3. Being Kind and Respectful

- I will be kind when I am online, just like I am in school.
- I will not send unkind messages or share anything that might hurt someone.
- I will respect other people's work and ideas.

4. Using Devices Responsibly

- I will take care of school devices and use them properly.
- I will not try to change settings, install apps, or access things I shouldn't.
- I will only use the internet when an adult gives me permission.

5. Thinking Before I Share

- I will not take photos, videos, or recordings of others without permission.
- I will not share photos or videos online unless a teacher says it is allowed.
- I understand that once something is shared online, it can be hard to remove.

6. Reporting Problems

- If something goes wrong, I will tell a teacher or trusted adult straight away.
- I will not try to fix problems myself or hide mistakes.

7. Being Honest

- I will not pretend to be someone else online.
- I will not use someone else's username or password.
